**The whole Easter story**: Why the cross is good news for all creation - by Jo Swinney from A Rocha International



Explore the profound meaning of Easter beyond personal spirituality. There is no doubt that each of us has a place in the Easter story. but what happened on the cross is not just a story of me and Jesus. It is far deeper and wider than that. In this Lenten journey, Jo Swinney explores the broader impact of the Easter story on God's relationship with creation. Through Bible readings, reflections and stories, discover how the cross transforms not just our own individual connection with Jesus, but also our

relationships with each other and our world.
